English	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Reading 10-20 minutes daily. ❖ Reading Eggs (passwords sent home) ❖ Create a restaurant – make your own menu and role play with your family. ❖ Role-play being a teacher and create worksheets of your own to do with your siblings or parents. ❖ Soundwaves – complete tasks if able to. Mathematics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Mentals – complete a day of mentals daily ❖ Cook at home – count, measure, compare and weigh ingredients, ❖ Play board games that encourage counting (Snakes and Ladders) ❖ Order objects at home from smallest to largest or lightest to heaviest. ❖ K- practise counting to 100, backwards from 30, skip counting by 2's. Year 1 and 2 – skip counting by 2's, 5's and 10's. ❖ Play shops – label items with costs, sell items and give change ❖ K- Practise writing numbers to 20 ❖ iMaths – Kindergarten (p21, 23, 24, 35) Year 1 – (p42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49) Year 2 – (p44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 138, 139) If wanting to log onto iMaths online they can use this website: www.imathskids.com.au Passwords: (Kindergarten) bird541 (Year 1) here203 (Year 2) dish690

Creative Arts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Create a puppet show or play for your family. ❖ Draw what you see in your garden. ❖ Make your own Henri Matisse artwork using scissors to draw like we have been learning about in class. ❖ Design a new cover for a book that you love to read.
