Dear Parents,

Starting next week K-2 will be trialing an online learning platform called Seesaw from Monday 6th April – Thursday 9th April. All parents will receive an email with their child's unique online password or QR code. Seesaw will allow myself to send morning messages, a time table of the day and set activities. It will also allow students to respond to tasks in a variety of different ways including photos, drawing, microphone, text and video.

Each morning the students will receive a morning message in their inbox with the daily timetable. Students can click on the activities tab to see all the activities for the day. There will be a combination of online and offline work for the students to complete. If there is any student that does not have access to technology, please contact the school and there is the ability to provide a device for the duration of learning from home. The weekly timetable will be posted on the schools website in the notes section and on the link posted to our school Facebook account.

Daily Tasks: The daily tasks that will be posted are a guide to continue learning from home. Your child does not need to complete the tasks within the period of the day. It may suit your family to complete the daily tasks in the morning, afternoon or evening. We understand that many families are going to be under a lot of pressure and changed routines at the moment. Please keep in mind the mental health of your child is of the utmost importance.

Parent/Carer and Support:

To begin with, our K-2 students will require a great deal of assistance and support to complete their daily tasks. We hope that as our students become more familiar with this style of learning, that they will develop some level of independence.

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







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How To for Students:

Home Learning with Seesaw

 CLASS app.seesaw.me	<p>STEP 1: Tablet/phone: Download the Seesaw Class app on your device. You cannot access Seesaw through Safari. You must have the app for tablet/phone devices. Computer: Open Google Chrome. Go to app.seesaw.me to get started.</p>
	<p>STEP 2: Click 'I'm a Student' to log in with your Home Learning Code that was provided in an email by Miss Handley.</p>
	<p>STEP 3: Enter your Home Learning Text Code or scan your Home Learning QR Code when you see this page.</p>
	<p>STEP 4: Once logged in, you will be in your student journal where you can create posts, complete activities, and see Announcements from your teacher.</p>
	<p>STEP 5: The first thing you must do every morning is click on the inbox tab. Every morning Miss Handley will post a morning message and the daily timetable straight to your inbox.</p>
	<p>STEP 6: Next you must click the activities tab to see activities from your teacher (on the right side under class name).</p>
	<p>STEP 6: Click 'Add Response' to respond.</p>
	<p>STEP 7: Always press the green check to save work to your journal.</p>
	<p>STEP 8: Good job! Now Miss Handley will be able to see your work.</p>
